Medical school teaches interns a broad range of medical knowledge, basic clinical skills, and limited experience practicing medicine while medical residency gives in-depth training within a specific branch of medicine. However, the Fellowship Training Program is divided into different subspecialties such as cardiology; dermatology; endocrinology, diabetes and metabolism; gastroenterology; geriatric medicine; hematology; infectious diseases; nephrology; neurology; oncology; pulmonary medicine and rheumatology.
